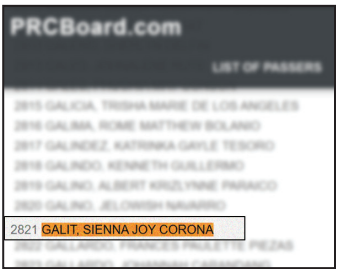

EUROPEAN UNION APPROVES ESTA PROJECT



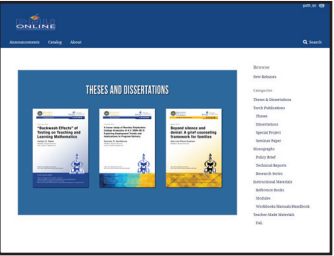
The PNU team during their meeting on December 18, 2019 for ESTA project
