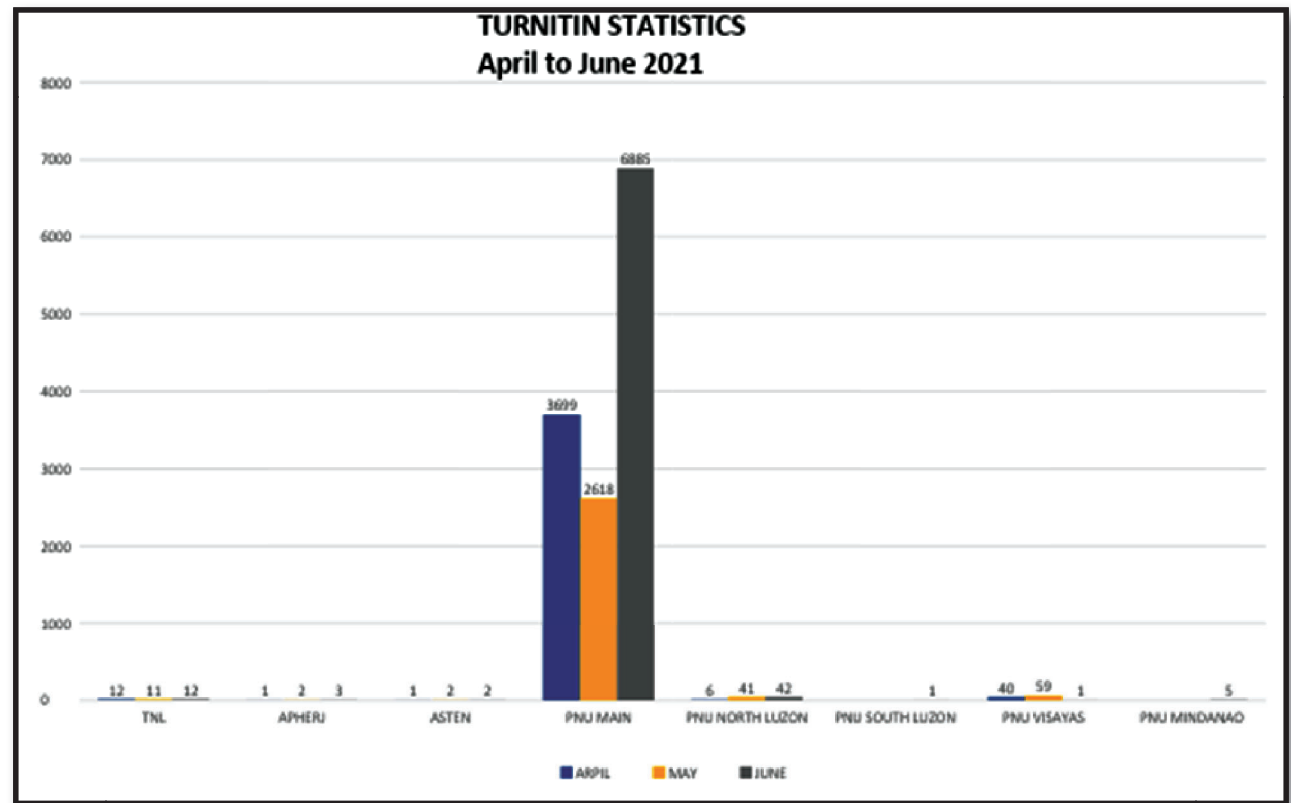




Turnitin Usage Statistics 2nd Quarter 2021

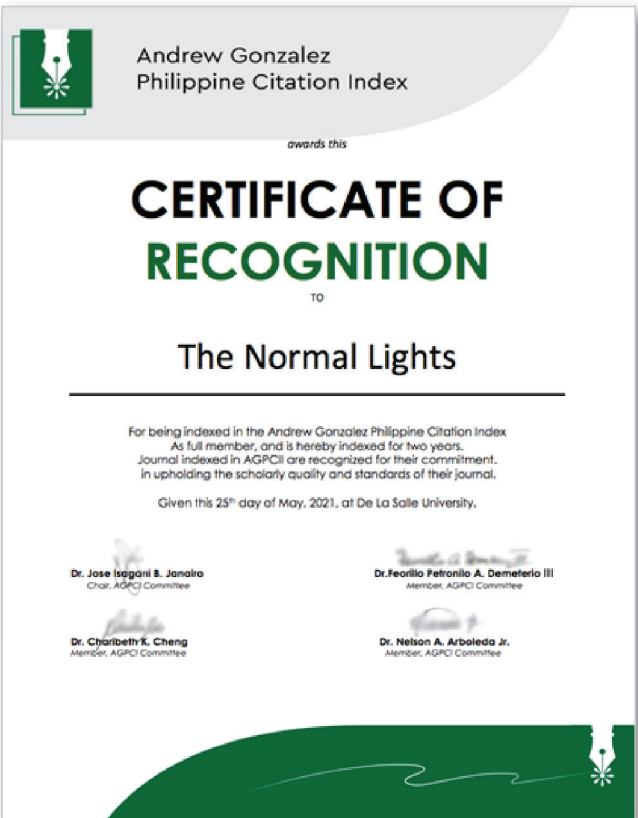

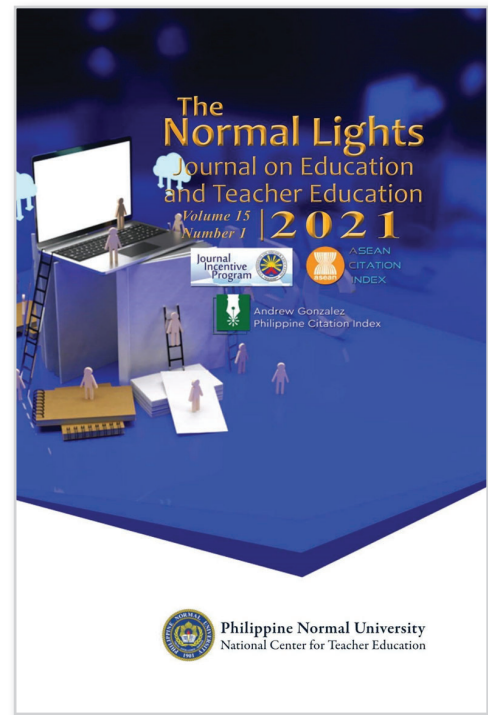
