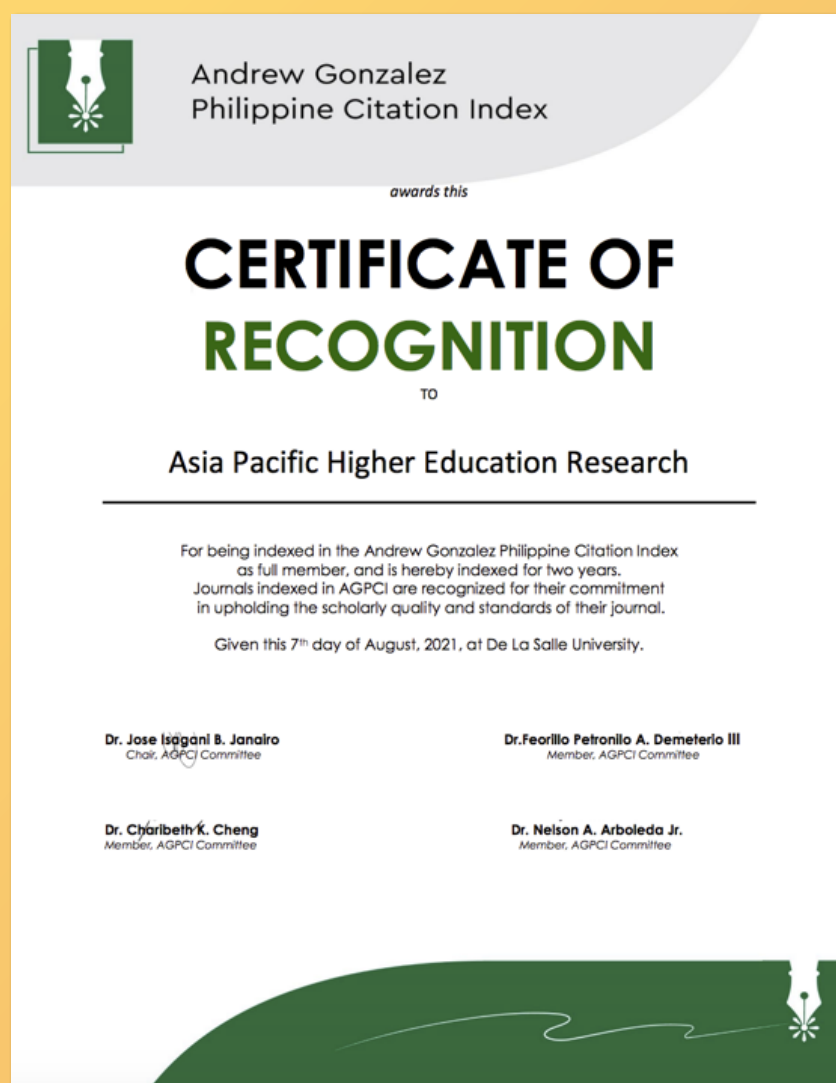




APHERJ indexes in AGPCI (August 7, 2021)

Allan S. Mabunga, the editorial team, and the peer reviewers of the journal.

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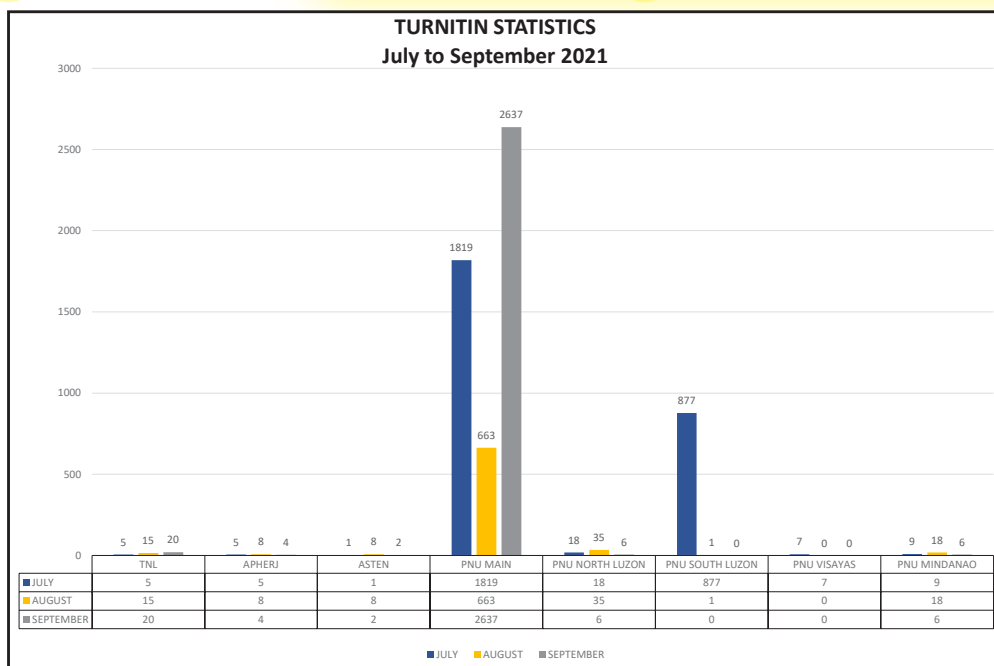
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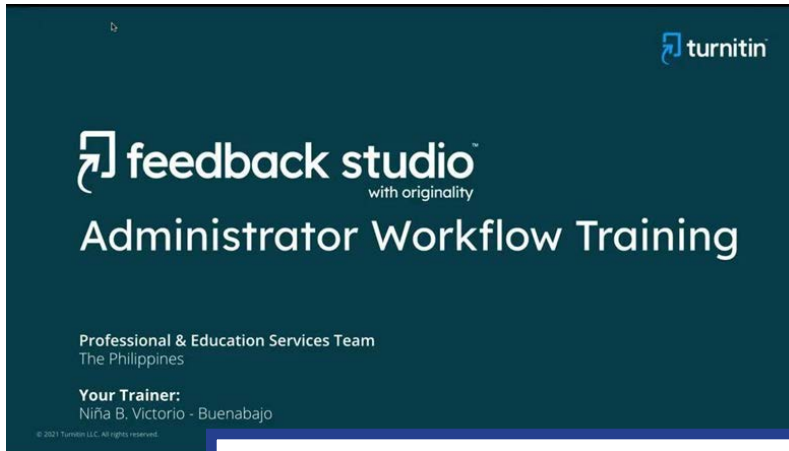
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PO launches Quicklinks for Turnitin Users (August 20, 2021)

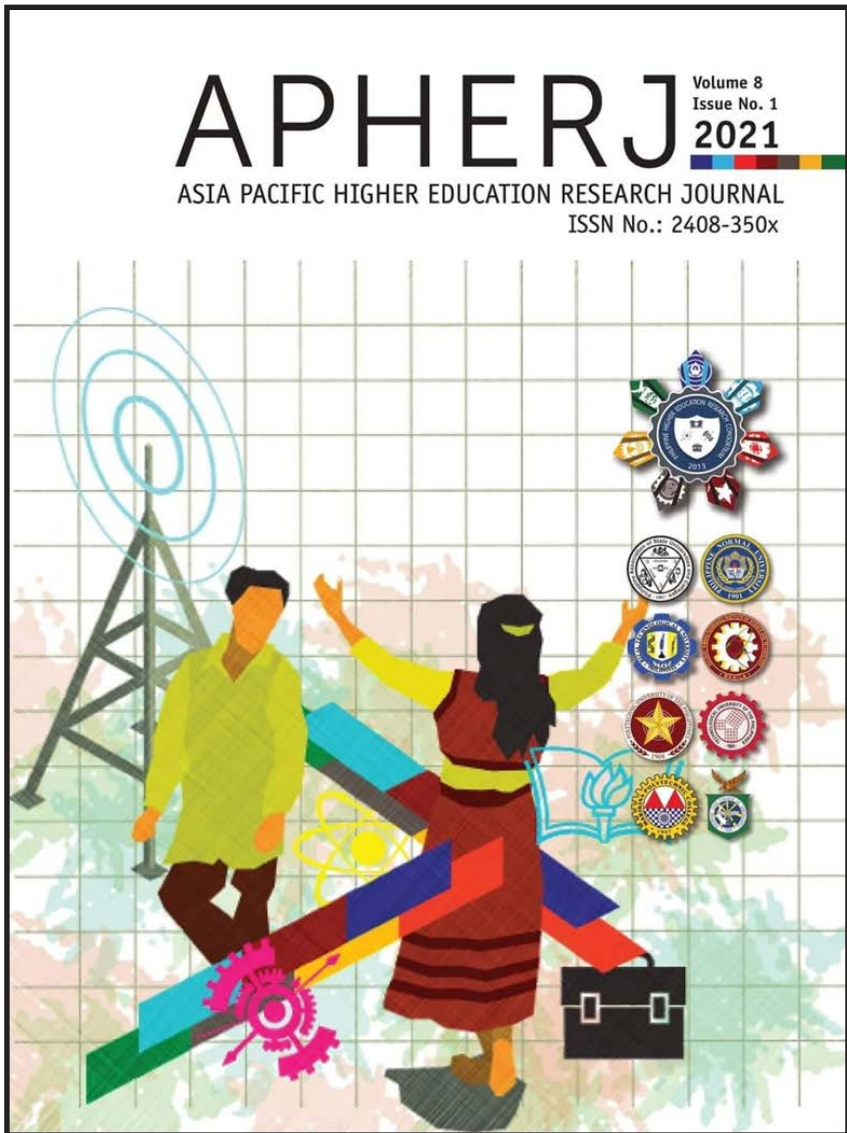
