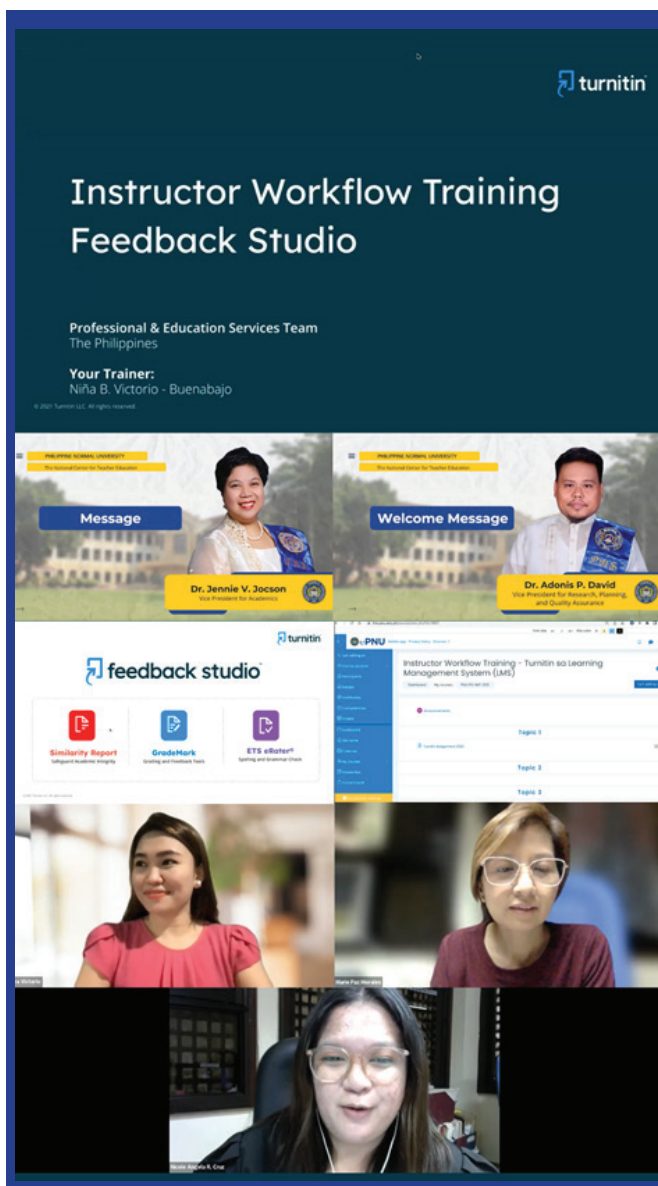

**Turnitin Feedback Studio and Originality
Instructors' Workflow Training**
October 19, 2022

The PNU-Publication Office, in collaboration with Turnitin Philippines, conducted the Turnitin Feedback Studio and Originality Instructor's Workflow on October 19, 2022. The online training held via zoom video conferencing aimed to assist PNU faculty in efficiently utilizing the plagiarism detection software and to help the PNU faculty learn best practices for its usage in ePNU (the Learning Management System of the University).

The training session commenced with the messages of Dr. Adonis David (Vice President for Research, Planning, and Quality Assurance) and Dr. Jennie V. Jocson (Vice President for Academics), who conveyed their support during the program. Ms. Nina Victorina Buenbajo, a Professional Educational Specialist from Turnitin, covered multiple topics such as interpreting originality reports, managing and setting up assignments and using the features of Turnitin Feedback Studio to detect and prevent plagiarism. The Publication Office plans to continue providing training programs to encourage PNU educators and students to promote and practice academic integrity.

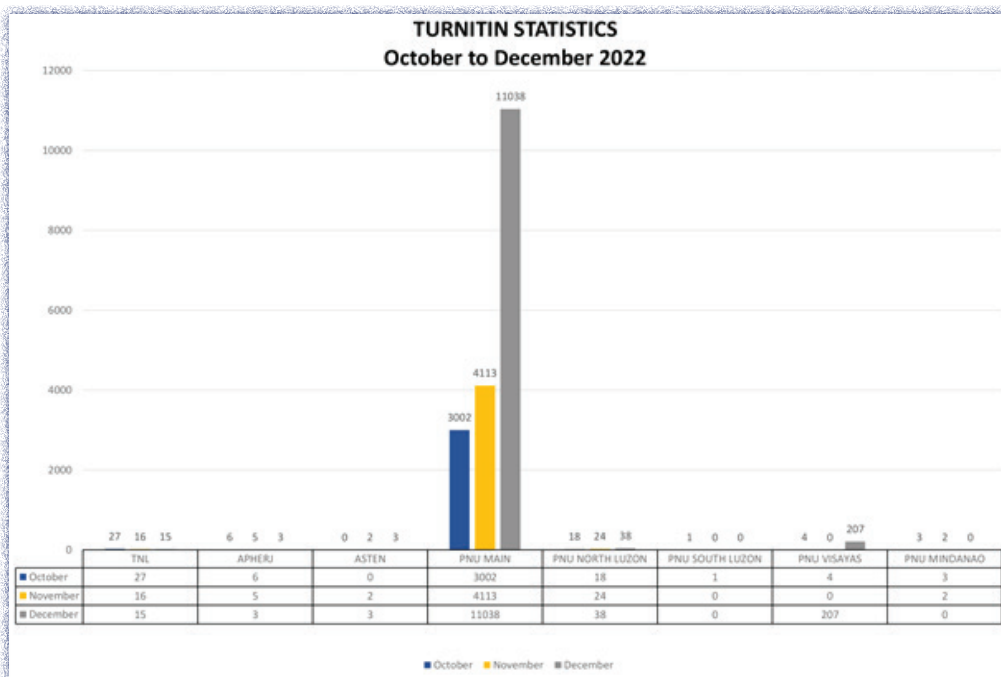

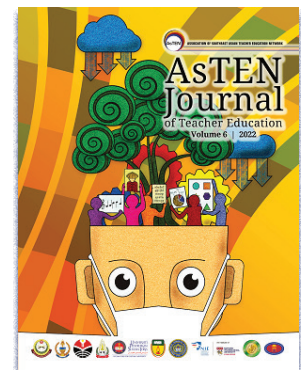


PNU faculty highlighting the expertise and research of the university.

On October 16-18, 2022, the ESTA-PNU team represented by Mr. Alfons Jayson O. Pelgone, Dr. Arlyne C. Marasigan, and Dr. Ruth A. Alido joined the Academic Staff Tour at Ludwigsburg University of Education in

Germany along with other members from the

participating universities.

The three-day event focused on visits of student laboratory, observation of the work with diverse group of

students, laboratory work on the development of experiments and worksheets, visit at the lower secondary school in Ludwigsburg, interview of the school principal and different science teachers, presentations on pedagogical scientific language knowledge as well as the chemistry capital and cultural differences in chemistry, and the management of the project highlighting the ways forward and the plans from each country. The participants were welcomed and were able to get to know each other over a dinner that happened after the event on the first day.
