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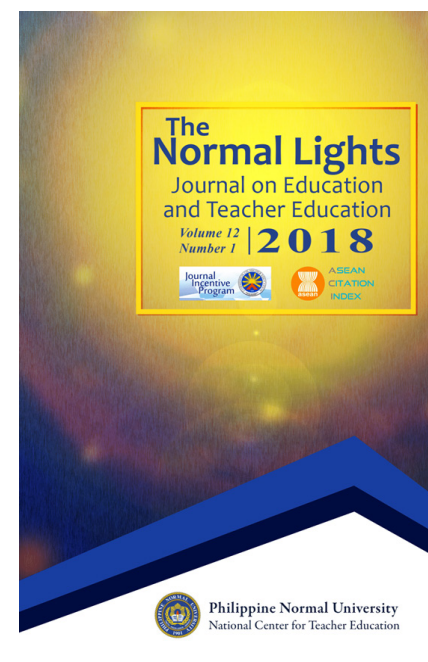

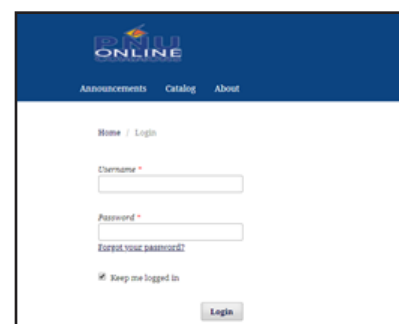
How to be a registered user of PNU Online Commons?

Upon enrollment, the student must send a pdf or jpeg copy of the Certificate of Registration (COR) or Official Receipt (OR) to purificacion.pmc@pnu.edu.ph or enrolled students can personally present their OR or COR to Ms. Patricia or Ms. Sienna at the Publication Office, Pedro Orata Hall, 2nd floor.

Once registered, you will automatically receive an email with your username and password.

Logging in

- Go to <http://pnu-onlinecommons.org/omp/index.php/pnu-oc/>
- Enter your username and password in the text fields



- Click the Log in button

Since the administrator created a randomly generated password for your account, you are required to change your password the first-time you log in to the system.

Catalog

You can view all uploaded materials when you click Catalog in the navigation bar.

About

The About section shows the Privacy Statement, Focus and Scope of the Press, Open Access Policy and the Review Policy in three parts: (1) preproduction, (2) production, and (3) post-production.

Categories

The PNU Online Commons has 10 categories: (1) Theses and Dissertations, (2)

Monographs, (3) Instructional Materials, (4) Teacher-made Materials, (5) Research Tools and Instruments, (6) Students Outputs, (7) Newsletter, (8) DepEd Resources, (9) Conference Proceedings, and (10) PRC-related documents. All the categories are located at the right side bar.

How to view materials in the system?

- The GUI (Graphical User Interface) of the PNU Online Commons is user-friendly so it will be easy for the users to understand the system. To view pdfs of the materials:
- Choose your desired category
- Click the Title of the paper that you wish to download
- Click the PDF button (*Note: It will take some time for the page to load*)



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
